Fair Play



- By entering into the tournament each player accepts Fair-Play measures as a condition of entry in a voluntary sports event and agrees that his/her participation takes place subject to these Fair-Play measures
- All games will be put through a fair play verification process involving statistical correlation analysis
- Internet transmission of all broadcasted games will be delayed by 15 minutes
- All players will be checked on entrance
 - No electronic devices are allowed in the playing area
 - Players are not allowed to wear their own watches or bring their own pens

Random personal inspections will be conducted after the games

Spectators are not allowed to stay in the playing area

Medical protocol

- All participants and technical staff will observe sanitary rules and will behave to minimize risks of infection
- Czech government currently does not impose any restrictions
- Medic on site in case of medical emergency during rounds





Dress code



- a pulled-together, harmonious, complete look, the pieces of the clothing should be clean, show no excessive wear or holes
 - blouses, turtleneck, t-shirts or polo-shirts
 - trousers, jeans or slacks, skirts, dresses
 - appropriate footwear (boots, flats, mid-heel or high-heel shoes, sneakers with sock)
 - jacket, vest or sweater, a scarf, as well as jewelry (earrings, necklace, etc.)
- no caps or hats, except for religious reasons
- national costumes which fit into the generally accepted dress code can be worn
